








Read Timing Waveform (1) ($\overline{WE} = V_{IH}$)












Write Timing Waveform (1) (\overline{WE} Controlled)





Write Timing Waveform (2) ($\overline{\text{CS}}$ Controlled)




Low V_{CC} Data Retention Timing Waveform
