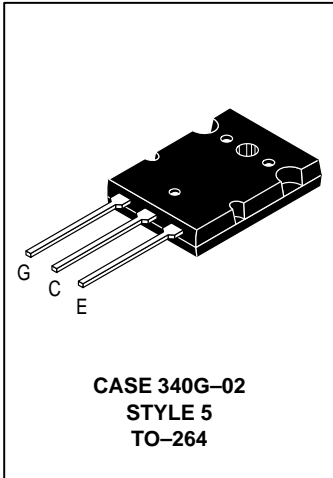
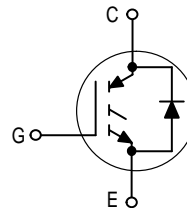

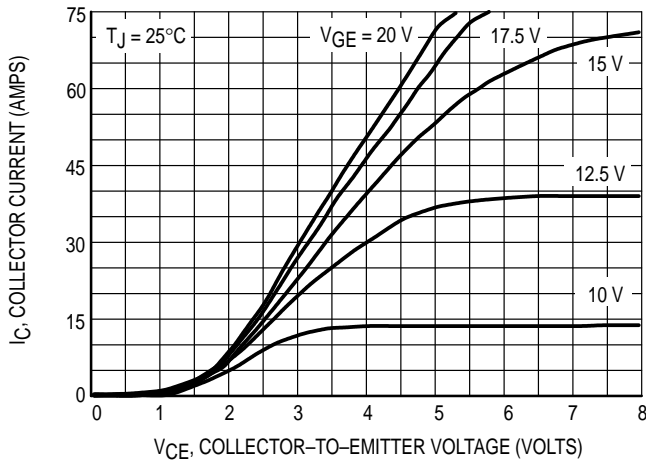


Figure 1. Output Characteristics

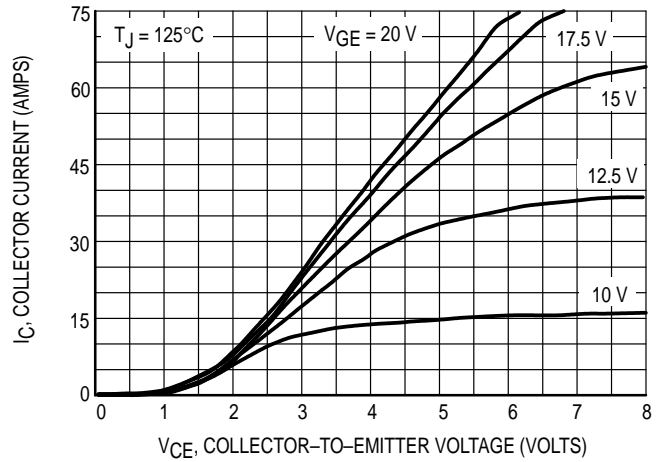


Figure 2. Output Characteristics

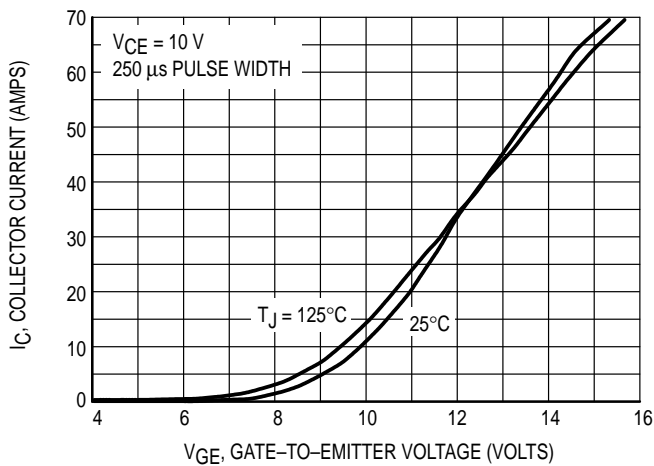


Figure 3. Transfer Characteristics

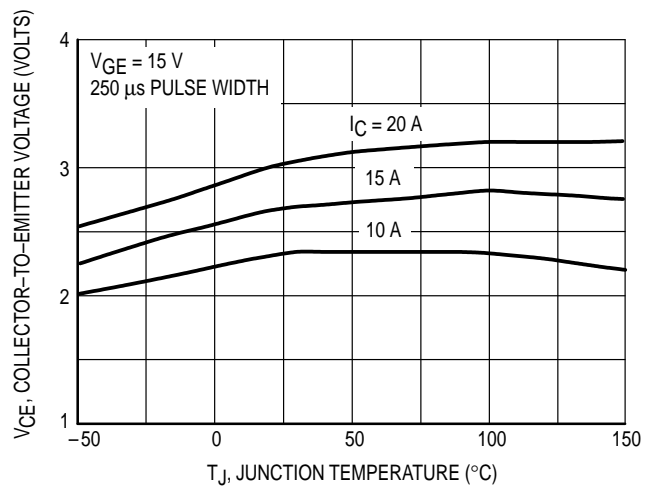


Figure 4. Collector-to-Emitter Saturation Voltage versus Junction Temperature

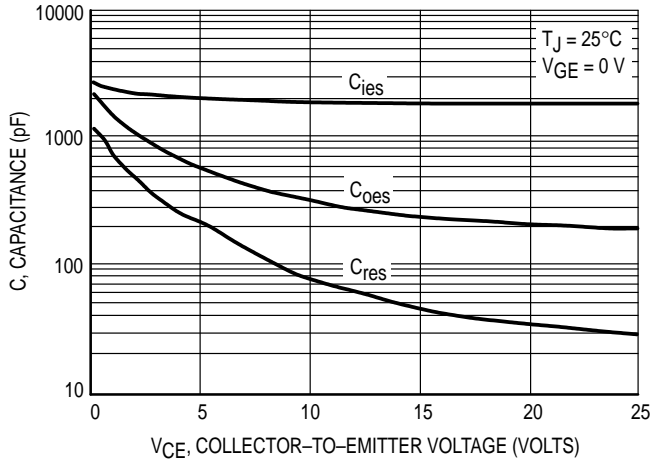


Figure 5. Capacitance Variation

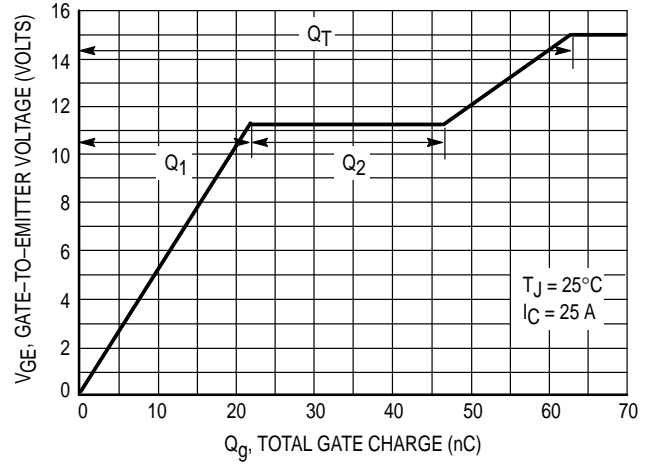


Figure 6. Gate-to-Emitter Voltage versus Total Charge

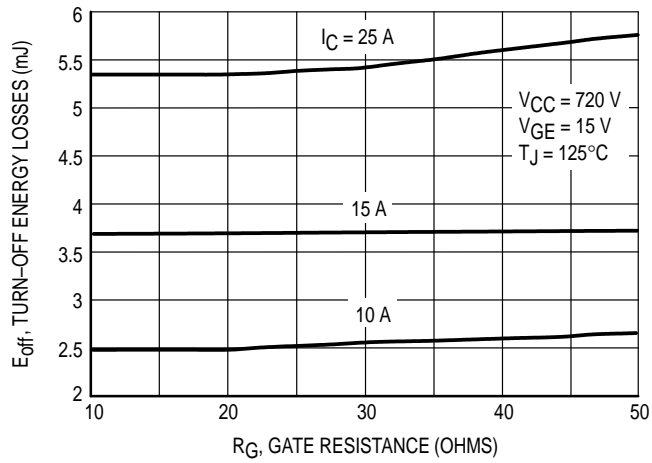


Figure 7. Turn-Off Losses versus Gate Resistance

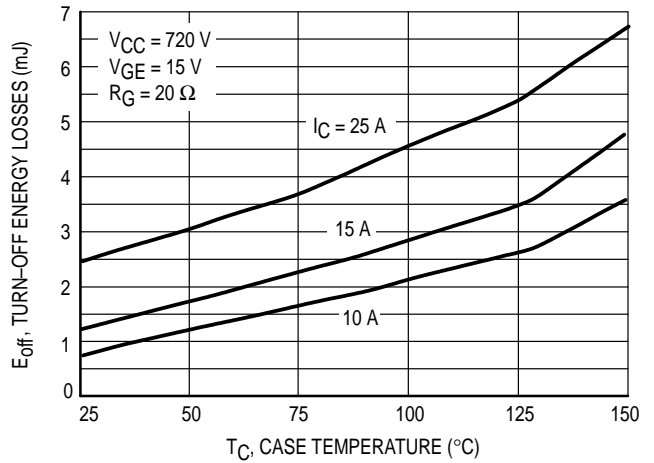


Figure 8. Turn-Off Losses versus Case Temperature

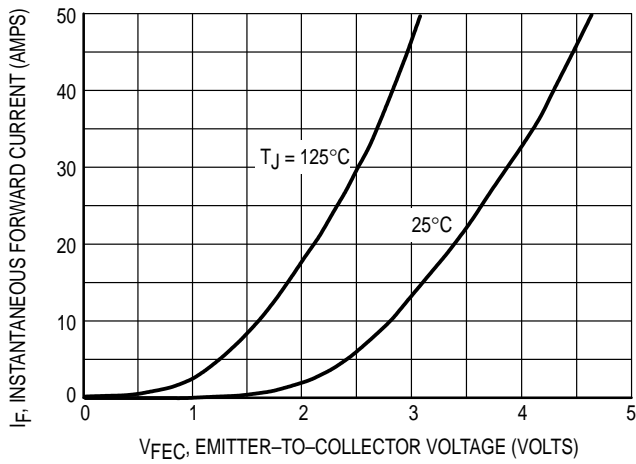


Figure 9. Diode Forward Voltage Drop

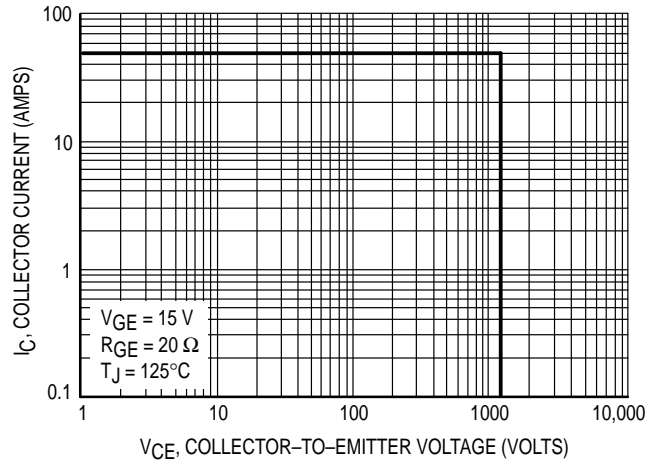


Figure 10. Reverse Biased Safe Operating Area

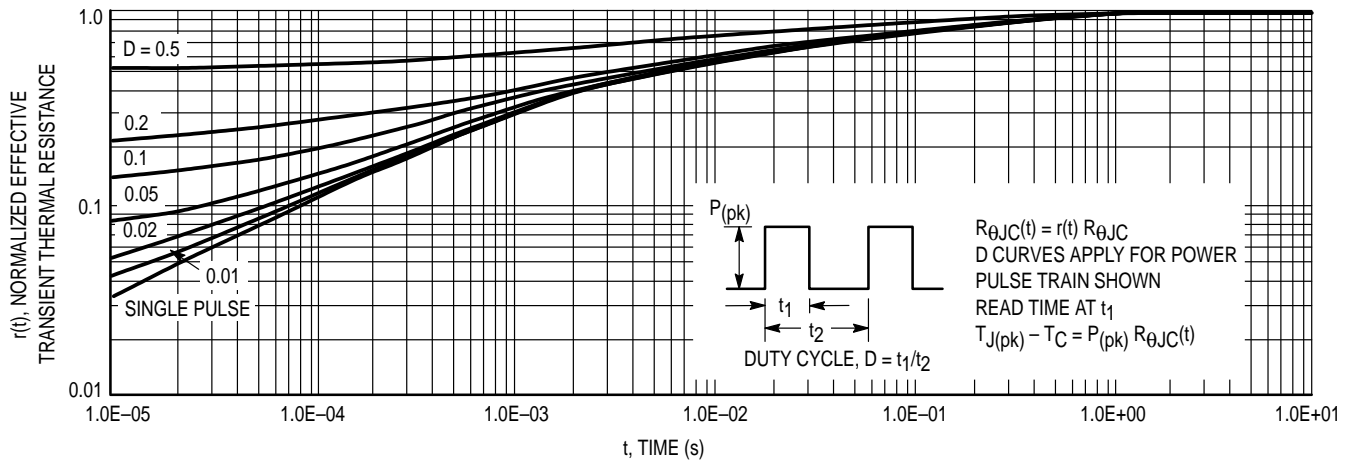
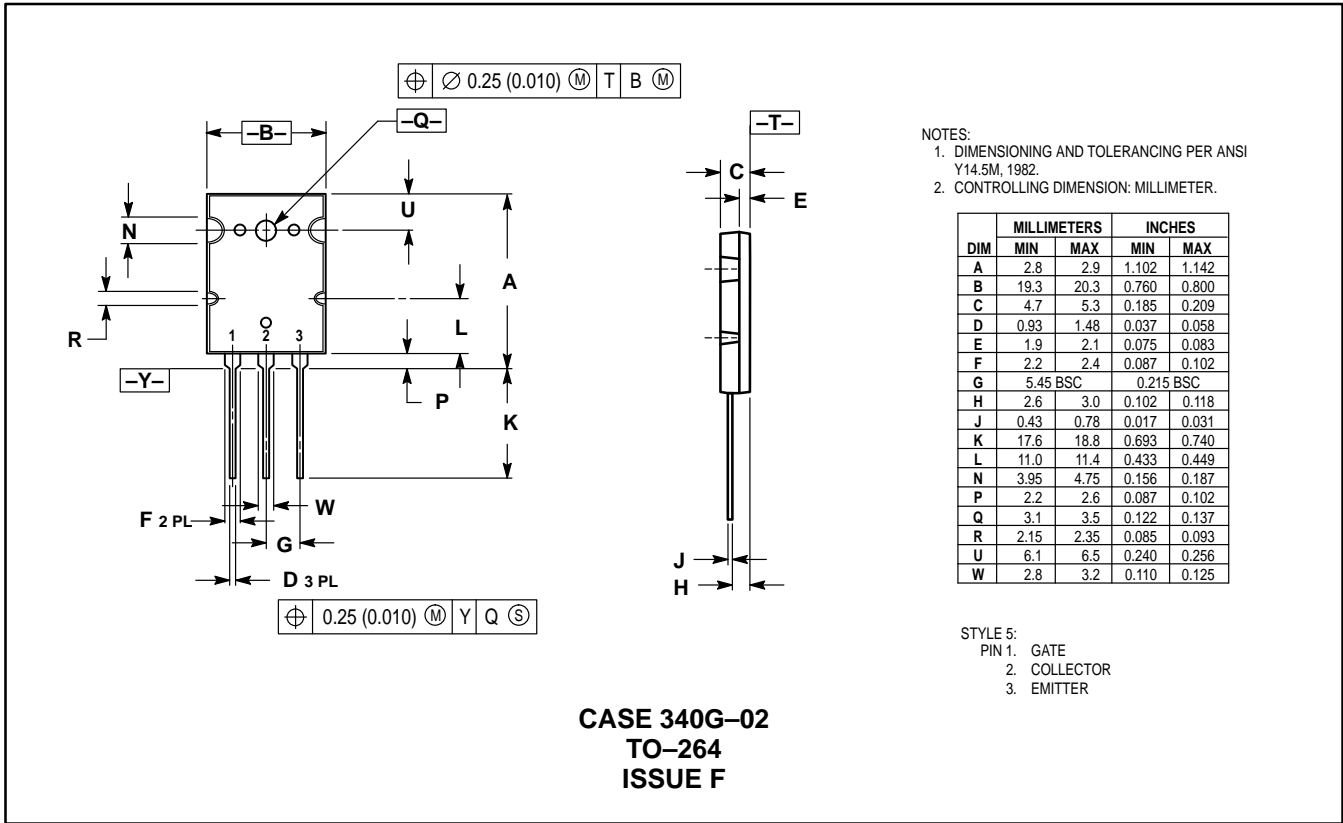


Figure 11. Thermal Response
