

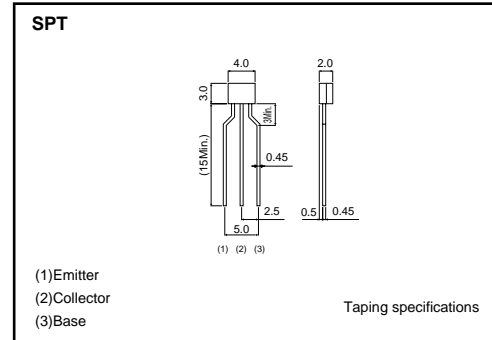

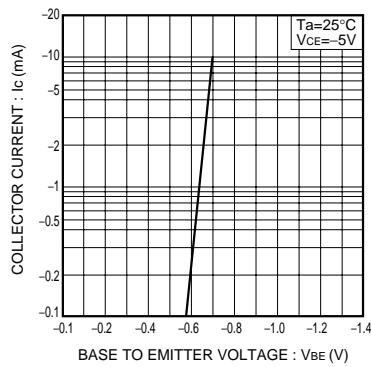


Fig.1 Ground emitter propagation characteristics

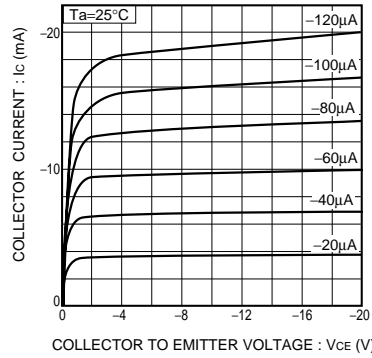


Fig.2 Ground emitter output characteristics (I)

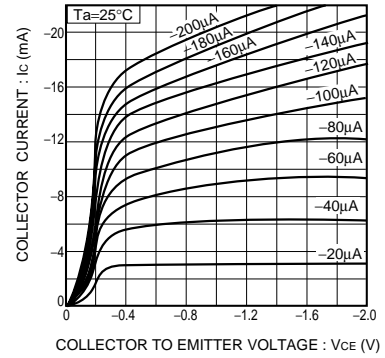


Fig.3 Ground emitter output characteristics (II)

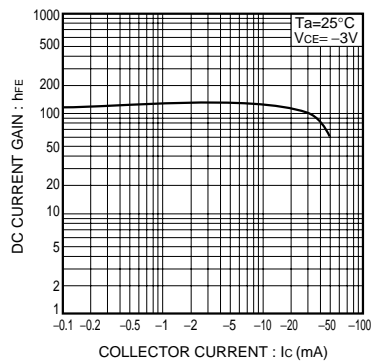


Fig.4 DC current gain vs. collector current

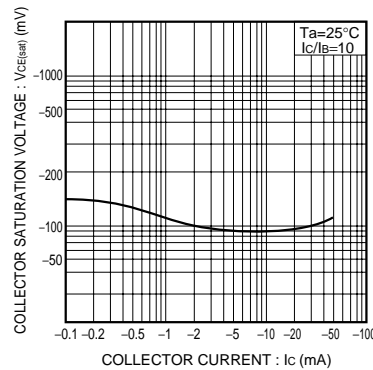


Fig.5 Collector-emitter saturation voltage vs. collector current

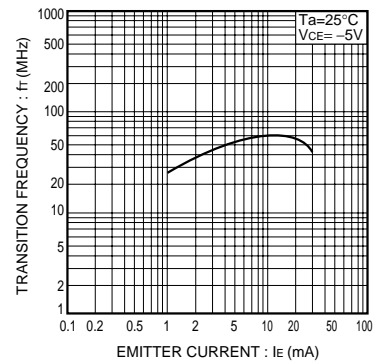


Fig.6 Gain bandwidth product vs. emitter current

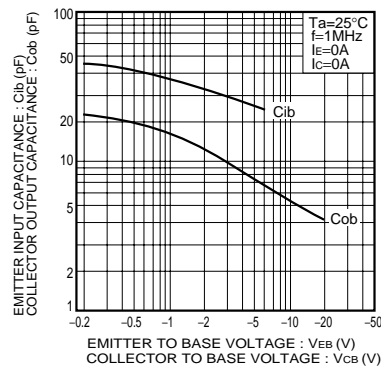


Fig.7 Emitter input capacitance vs. emitter-base voltage
