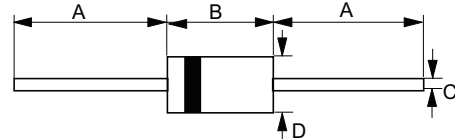

FIG. 1-TYPICAL FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

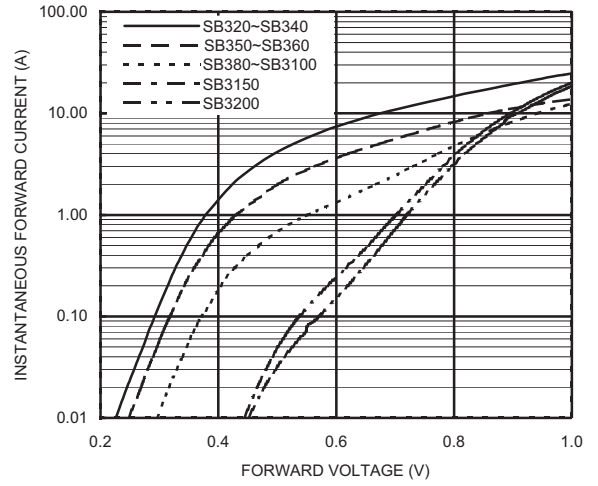
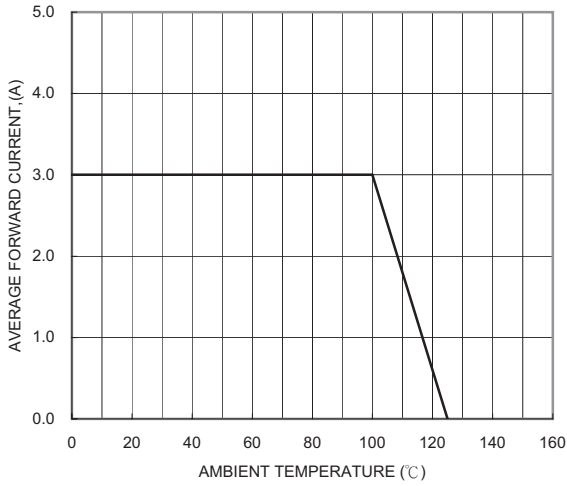


FIG. 3-MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

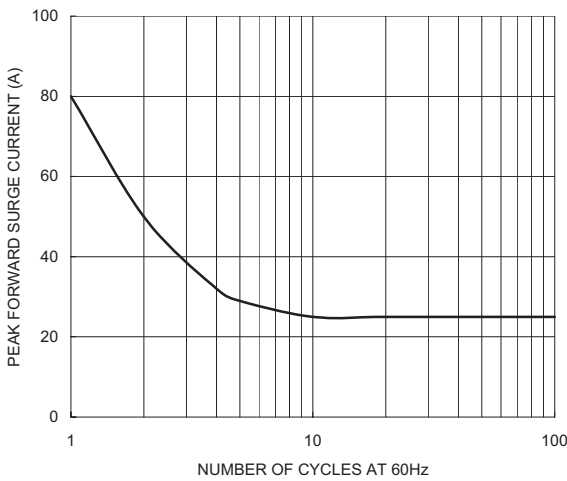


FIG. 4-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

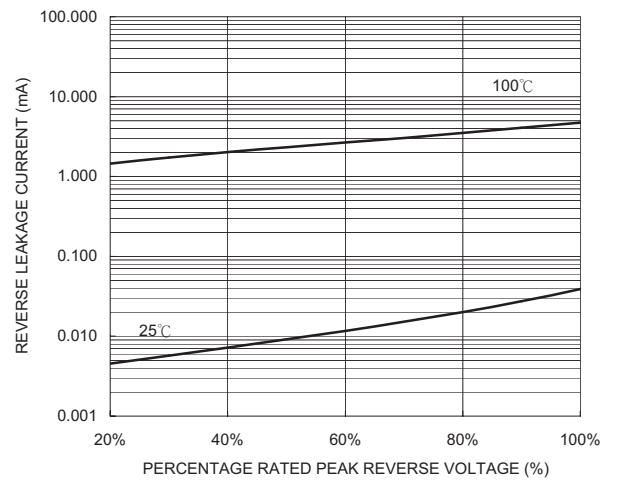


FIG. 5-TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE
