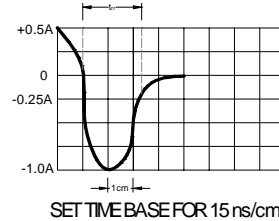

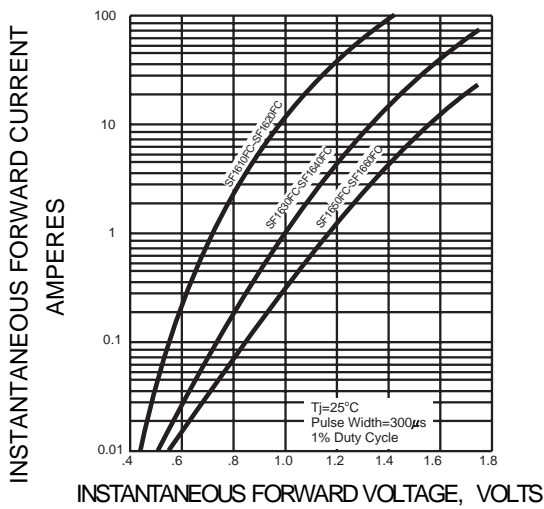

**FIG.1 – TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM AND REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC**

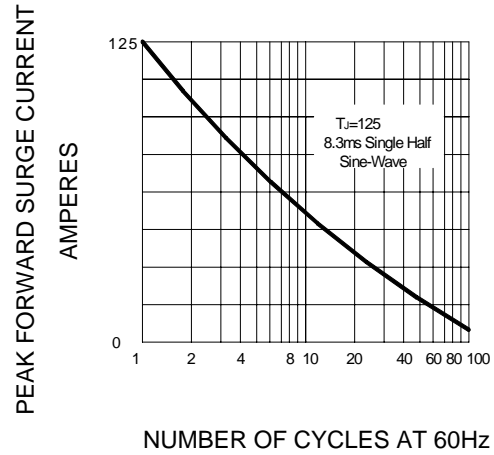


NOTES:1.RISE TIME = 7ns MAX.INPUT IMPEDANCE = 1MΩ, 22pF.
