




Figure 1. Maximum Forward Current Derating Curve




Figure 2. Forward Power Loss Characteristics




Figure 3. Typical Instantaneous Forward Characteristics




Figure 4. Typical Reverse Leakage Characteristics




Figure 5. Typical Junction Capacitance





Figure 6. Typical Transient Thermal Impedance
